

Policy Statement

Acrobay Gymnastics Trust is fully committed to ensuring that all of our gymnasts receive the most appropriate routine(s) to support a partnership's progression and performance.

What we will do

- At the end of each competition season, the coaches and choreographer will review all routines and decide which routines will be able to be reused and which partnerships will be offered new routines.

New Routine(s)

- Choreographer and coaches will source pieces of music appropriate to the partnership
- Gymnasts will be offered a selection of music, from which they may select their preferred piece.
- Choreographer will choreograph the new routine and teach this to the gymnasts
- Choreographer will obtain any required music licences

Existing Routine(s)

- Coaches and choreographer will advise on most appropriate routines for that partnership.
- These routines will be taught or learnt in the gym

New & Existing Routine(s)

- Any music editing, choreography adjustments, or routine polishing will be carried out at no additional cost during training sessions.

We will regularly monitor and evaluate the implementation of this policy and includes children's views in this process

What you can do

- You can chose to use an existing routine(s), where appropriate. Coaches and choreographer will advise on most appropriate routine(s) for that partnership.
- If you are offered an existing routine, and would prefer to opt for a new routine, this can be discussed with the coach and choreographer. If all in agreement you will then be offered a selection of music which will be chosen by the coaches and choreographer, from which you can select your preferred piece.

CHOREOGRAPHY & ROUTINE POLICY

- If the coach and choreographer recommend a new routine(s), you may opt in for a new routine or opt out and take an existing routine. Again recommendations would be given by the choreographer and coach.
- Respect the choreographer and coaches recommendations

Choreography Fees Structure

New Routine	£100 per gymnast	<i>Pair - £200 Trio - £300 Mens 4 - £400</i>
Existing Routine	Free	
Display Team Routine	£170 per minute	<i>A display team consisting of 24 gymnasts performing a 7 minute routine would be:- £170 x 7 = £1190 / 24 = £49.60 per gymnast)</i>

Any music editing, choreography adjustments or routine polishing will be carried out at no additional cost during training sessions

Payments should be arranged direct with the choreographer. The club will not be involved in this.

Partnership Breakdown

- If a partnership splits mid-season, the routine(s) will be treated as an existing routine, and the coaches/choreographer will decide how it is reassigned. The club/choreographer will not be involved in any financial disputes between partnerships.
- When a partnerships changes at the end of the season, then the coaches/choreographer will decide how it is reassigned. The club/choreographer will not be involved in any financial disputes between partnerships.

Music Licence

- If a partnership is selected to represent Great Britain, gymnasts will be required to obtain a music license via Click n Clear. This would be for each piece of music used in their routine(s) (*some routines have a few pieces of music in the same routine and each piece would require a license*). The costs of these licenses will be shared equally between the partnership
